## New Member Info

The National dues are \$185 (National Dues also include membership access to AllPony.com)

Regional dues \$75

Club dues \$35

Regional and Club dues both have discounts for siblings

Optional \$15 Sponsor Fee (We would like all parents to be sponsors which means you are active with the club and willing to help volunteer, etc, and have a right to vote at Annual Meeting)

Make checks payable to Desert Hooves Pony Club. DHPC will submit Regional and National Dues on your behalf.

As a member, National Pony Club will send new members log-in information for the member-only area of the USPC website as well as an USPC logo pin. This pin should be worn on the shirt collar at every PC event (mounted and unmounted).

Mounted meetings are \$30 per lesson and unmounted meetings are \$5 per lesson (to be paid at the attended event). This covers the cost to pay for the instructors. All kids must wear an armband or an ID bracelet at all times during Pony Club meetings and events. Medical ID armbands are available on the [Pony Club Website](#). However, many members have chosen to purchase an ID bracelet from Road ID, as they are more comfortable (<https://www.roadid.com/c/Wrist>).

The following information must be visible on the ID for it to be Pony Club compliant. Barcodes (or any codes used in medical facilities) are not acceptable for Pony Club. Below is the information that must be shown on the bracelet:

- Name and Date of Birth
- Emergency Contact Information
- Known Allergies
- Current Medications
- Existing Medical Conditions

In addition to the armbands, members are required to wear proper attire at all events and meetings. When at an unmounted event/clinic where we are representing DHPC, the required uniform is a red button-up, short-sleeve polo, tan breeches/tights, belt and boots (half-chaps optional).

We ask all members to have a red polo embroidered with the DHPC logo and the USPC logo. You purchase a red polo from our embroiderer (or bring your own red polo). We will give you the information for our embroiderer at the time of membership. The red polo is worn during any Club event, such as volunteering, field trips, etc.

During any mounted event or meeting, members are required to wear the appropriate riding and safety equipment for that discipline.
